How to read this table

- **Min Lot Size** → Smallest lot size you can use on that index
- **Stop Level (Points)** → Example point move used for testing
- **Stop Level (\$USD)** → Cost in USD for that point move — helps you size your trades properly

👉 Remember: Volatility Indices use **points**, not pips — and the scaling varies between indices. Always adjust your lot size and stop loss to fit your account risk.
